IGUAZU FALLS

DETAILED ITINERARY EXTENSION Sep 15 / 23



Feel the thunder of Iguazu with its hundreds of individual falls. Iguazu straddles the Brazilian-Argentine border in the vast, sub-tropical nature reserve of Iguazu National Park. Iguazu is hailed by many as the world's most impressive waterfall.

The falls are formed by the Rio Iguazu, which has its source near Curitiba. Beginning at an altitude of 4500 feet, the river winds westward, collecting tributaries along the way, increasing its size and power. About 10 miles before reaching the Rio Parana, the Iguazu broadens and plunges over a 270 foot cliff to form Iguazu Falls.

The name Iguazu comes from the local Indian language and means Big Water. Surrounded by rainforest and next to little development, Iguazu is a natural highlight not to be missed.

DAY 1 ARRIVE IN IGUAZU AIRPORT

Upon arrival at Iguazu Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel in Iguazu National Park on either the Brazilian or Argentine side of the falls. Enjoy the grounds, have a swim in the pool or explore the Park's walkways right at your hotel doorstep. (D)

DAY 2 ARGENTINE WATERFALLS

After breakfast at the hotel, depart for a full day tour of the Argentine side of the falls, including lunch. The views are magnificent, especially from the top of Devil's Throat. (B, L, D)

DAY 3 BRAZILIAN WATERFALLS

Following breakfast, visit the Brazilian side of Iguazu Falls. Walk through sub-tropical rainforest to reach the bottom of Salto Floriano. From here, take an elevator to the top of the falls. (B, L, D)

Please Note: The sightseeing tours may operate on alternate days. Transfers and tours include assistance with border crossings as necessary. This tour is not exclusive to ElderTreks, which means that you may be joined by other international passengers of various ages.

DAY 4 DEPARTURE

Transfer to the airport for your flight back to Buenos Aires. (B)
